

# Golfer of the Year 2025

Golfer of the year will follow the same format as 2023 and 2024, with more focus on the full playing season. Like last year we will award prizes for the overall winner, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

The majority\* of closed Singles competitions will count toward the Golfer of the Year with competitions designated a points plan determined by Major/non-Major status. In addition, points will be awarded to the winner, runner-up and semi-finalists of the Nancy Cup.

This year the Golfer of the Year will commence after the Spring League competition and will conclude with the last scheduled Monthly Medal.

**NOTE:** A minimum number of 70 entrants is needed for a competition to have Golfer of the Year points awarded.

\*Qualifying events will not be included, e.g. Nancy Cup Qualifier, Captain's Day Qualifier etc will not count toward Golfer of the Year.

\*\*Although a fully developed handicap is needed to win a major, this requirement does not apply to the Golfer of the Year points allocation.

## **IN THE CASE OF A TIE:**

In the unlikely event where two or more players end the season on the same number of points, the player with the greatest number of 1<sup>st</sup> place finishes will prevail, if still tied then the greatest number of 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes and lastly the greatest number of 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishes. If there is still a tie, we will declare joint winners of Player of the Year.
